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

Final approval must await final figures for legitimate class claimants.</p> <p>The court also will need the Administrator's final estimated invoice for its services.</p> <p>Detailed hourly billing breakdowns are required from <u>all</u> of plaintiffs' law firms or attorneys who intend their hours to be considered in the lodestar base to be used to cross-check the attorneys' fees requested, and who want to be awarded part of the \$3.39 million in attorneys' fees requested here. Charts summarizing those hours are not adequate (with the possible exception of the Cypen situation). In addition, the proposed Order must list the award for each separate counsel, as requested in the moving papers, and not just provide for the award of a lump sum.</p> <p>The waiver of interest on plaintiffs' attorneys' fees and costs takes care of that issue.</p> <p>Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of Payment by Defendants of Administrative Costs to Settlement Administrator is granted. Although the court is permitting defendants to pay the third invoice of Administrator Gilardi &amp; Co. LLC in the amount of \$19,888.04, the court expressly reserves final approval of the Administrator's fees for the continued final fairness hearing, tentatively set for September 21, 2018.</p> <p>Plaintiffs are ordered to give notice unless notice is waived.</p>
